Second Substantial Amendment to the
47th Program Year (2021-22) Housing and Community Development Consolidated Annual Plan
(47-02)**

Reprogramming for the Community Development Block Grant

Purpose

In accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations (found under 24 CFR Parts 91.105 and 91.505), and the City's Citizen Participation Plan, the City of Los Angeles is required to provide citizens with an opportunity to comment on all proposed Substantial Amendments to its Housing and Community Development Consolidated Annual Plan (Con Plan). The City wishes to notify the public of a substantial amendment to its 47th Program Year (PY 47) 2021-22 Con Plan.

A 30-day public comment period will provide the public with an opportunity to review and comment on this proposed second amendment, beginning about December 20, 2021 and ending January 22, 2022.

Proposed Changes- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)

Since the City Council and Mayor adopted the PY 47 Con Plan budget on July 1, 2021, the following change has been proposed for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

Council District 15, in consultation with the Housing Authority of the City of Los Angeles (HACLA), proposed to utilize a portion of the CDBG funds allocated to the Wilmington Multipurpose and Senior Center to install furnishings and a shade structure at the Harbor Boulevard Linear Park Project. The Harbor Boulevard Linear Park Project is expected to begin construction in 2022, and the Wilmington Multipurpose and Senior Center Improvement project is expected to begin later. Therefore, it is proposed that \$500,000 in CDBG funds awarded to the PY 47 Wilmington Multipurpose and Senior Center Improvements project be reprogrammed to the Harbor Boulevard Linear Park Project.
